Minnesota marked World Day of Remembrance at the State Capitol on Saturday, November 15, 2025. Candles flickered in honor of the people lost this year in traffic-related crashes across the state — each light representing a life cut short. Crash survivors, safety leaders, family members, law enforcement, and others impacted by crash deaths and injuries gathered in the Capitol Rotunda. World Day of Remembrance is a global event focusing on remembering victims and reducing crashes worldwide. The 6th annual event received Twin Cities media coverage.

Wrap Up Safety This Holiday Season!

Whether it's something special under the tree, or hands-on traffic safety activities at your organization's holiday party, we've got what you need this season! Having a fully loaded roadside emergency supply kit in your trunk is essential for safety. The Minnesota Safety Council has a ready-to-wrap Vehicle Emergency Kit and a Winter Emergency Kit available for order in time for the holidays. And if you're looking for party activities that will be both fun and educational, check out Drive Safe MN for these Interactive Tools available for loan:

- **Distract-A-Match:** Two rounds of matching are played, while being timed. One without distraction and one while texting.
- Distracted Driving Activity Mat: This mat has graphics depicting a rural town setting. Participants take their first spin around distraction free and the second time with their cell phone in one hand while texting.
- Driving Simulator: This device simulates driving with multiple distractions including cell phone ringing, text messages arriving and children or pets running into the street as the user "drives" along city streets and highways. Indoor use only.
- Pedal Cars with Fatal Vision Goggles: Get a realistic
 driving experience while wearing fatal vision impairment goggles.
 Participants pedal the car and navigate through the cones.
- Bean Bag Toss with/without Fatal Vision Goggles: Demonstrate the
 effects of impairment, such as depth perception, coordination and
 balance while attempting to toss bean bags while wearing goggles.

The holiday period between
Thanksgiving and New Year's
Day — with Christmas, Kwanzaa,
Hanukkah and other events in
between — means parties with
family, friends and co-workers
can often result in impaired
drivers getting behind the wheel.

During the 2019 – 2023 December months, 4,931 people were killed in alcoholimpaired-driving crashes. NHTSA has holidayready campaigns



that emphasize the dangers and consequences of drunk driving and drug-impaired driving:
